Even though emergencies do arise, any participant missing more than two (2) program days will be dropped from the program, and no portion of the tuition is refundable. **You may miss one (1) day for personal reasons and one (1) day for work-related reasons.**

- 3.1 understand that I am required to attend one **(1) public meeting**, such as the City Council or Quorum Court, and submit a summary report on your observations.
- 4. I understand that I am expected to fully participate in the group **community service project** that must be completed before graduation.
- 5.1 understand that there may be other activities (program planning meetings, graduation banquet, etc) in which all participants are expected to participate.
- 6.I understand that the tuition fee is \$850.00, and the full amount is due to the Mountain Home Area Chamber of Commerce one week prior to the first March session.
- 7.1 will not use content from the sessions or statements made therein for the purpose of news coverage.
- 8.1 will not use the name of Leadership Mountain Home in a political campaign to imply endorsement of Leadership Mountain Home.
- 9.1 release Mountain Home Leadership of any damages incurred to myself by participating in the programs.
